#### **Editorial**

Conventions are funny old things — I play a wide variety with different partners and it is not unusual to have hands that are unsuitable for any of the conventions during the whole session. One such convention I usually teach to Improvers is Extended Stayman — but I do warn students that mostly by the time it comes up they will have forgotten it!! In the past I've been fortunate to have a suitable hand with which to use it once a year......however so far this year I think it's come up

three times. Anyway, I thought I would share it with those of you who don't know it, as it will probably come up at least another three times this year!!

Unlike Stayman it is better used only after 1NT. You need an opening hand and five hearts and five spades.

After your partner's opening bid of 1NT you bid 2\* asking for a four card major. If partner replies with 2\* denying a four card major you then bid 3\* asking for your partner's best 3 card major. They must have one as you don't open 1NT with two doubletons.

Opener then bids their best 3 card major.

It is better not to use it after partner opens with 2NT as they may well have two doubletons in a stronger hand.

Below is a hand suitable for using Extended Stayman
